PROFILE

CITYNET Indonesia was established in Sukabumi on the 27th of December 2006 by all current Indonesian members of CITYNET Asia-Pacific in order to expand the network and spread the benefits of the network to other cities or urban areas in Indonesia that —for one reason or another— are not direct members of CITYNET Asia-Pacific.

While members of CITYNET Indonesia do not automatically become members of CITYNET Asia-Pacific, all Indonesian members of CITYNET Asia-Pacific are automatically members of CITYNET-Indonesia.

VISION

Similar to CITYNET Asia-Pacific, CITYNET Indonesia aims at promoting urban improvement initiatives in Indonesia through facilitating exchanges of knowledge and experience as well as technical cooperation among cities and other stakeholders in urban development (associations of municipalities, related research and training centers, universities, non-government organizations, community-based organizations, local businesses and the like).

CITYNET Indonesia also aims at providing forums for interactions and developing cooperation as well as exchanges of knowledge between Indonesian cities (and relevant stakeholders) and CITYNET Asia-Pacific member- cities or associate members from other countries.
